Daniel is a pastor and works with the chicken owners as a technical person. He invited us to speak to his church and connected us to another group of churches. These other leaders have recently left the Zionist cult which is a mixture of Christianity and African traditional religion. They are very excited about learning the truth and are asking us to teach them. Pray that God will lead us in this new relationship.
